Cancelling a walk

Very occasionally weather or ground conditions have become dire and the leader has to cancel. This is only done in extreme cases as most of us are prepared for some rain or mud but should the conditions become necessary to cancel for safety reasons then it is the leader's responsibility to contact the Secretary and ask for an email to be circulated announcing this. The leader however will still need to attend at the advertised time in the event that any members had failed to note the cancellation.

Leading a walk

A successful programme of walks (we aim to do a least twelve a year) requires a pool of walk leaders who are prepared to take on the task. Two of our regular leaders have, in the past twelve months, stood down making a heavier burden on those that remain. It is always good anyway to have new faces with fresh ideas leading us from time to time! As we tend to concentrate all our walks on the first Sunday of each month the leader's main concern is to fix the starting time and place (car parks are useful meeting places) and approximate distance. If there is a coffee shop or pub at the end all the better. It's a good plan to keep within the Dedham/Ardleigh/Bergholt/Langham parishes but we do often venture further afield.

At the start the leader would normally check that one of the participants will act as back marker (high visibility vest recommended) to ensure that we don't lose anybody. This is particularly important if the walk is well attended as our 2019 experience has been. There is nearly always somebody who will volunteer to do this. Throughout the walk the leader should be monitoring the pace and check to makes sure the group has not become strung out. If so a brief pause for catch up will be needed.

Sunday 5th Jan 2020 Leaders John Osborn & Marlene Townes.

Assemble Dedham War Memorial at 1030 for a local 'three churches' walk to E Bergholt and Stratford St Mary before returning to Dedham. Two hours of easy walking. If the flood meadows by the river are seriously flooded then an alternative walk will be substituted. The walk will end at the Duchy Barn (a few yards from the start) soon after 1230 and in good time for our AGM which is set to start at 1pm. Those members wishing to attend the meeting but not walking should aim to be there by 1pm. Hot drinks and mince pies will be provided.

Sunday 2nd February 2020 (10.30am start). Leader Ian Chapman. Meet in the car park immediately before the Dovercourt recycling centre, West End Lane Dovercourt CO12 3SF for a walk along the seafront to Harwich and return by a different route. We will have a half way stop so bring any drinks etc. and there are coffee shops and pubs nearby.
